Annual Report on Tresham Church – y/e 31 December 2024

Due to unbudgeted fees we had a small surplus on the General Fund of £551.

We had an overall surplus of £1440 (2023 £2401) increasing our Total Funds to £26,699

(£25,259). This was the combined result of our two funds: the General Fund and the

Restricted Fund.

The investment in The CBF Church of England Investment Fund is now valued at £31,460

(£29,932), an increase of 5.1% over the year making a profit to date of £24,003. Added

to our Total Funds this takes our total worth to £50,702 (£47,734).

The General Fund had a surplus of £551 (£381) and now stands at £7554. Receipts at

£889 were up £563, mainly on account of £460 Grants. Payments at £3214 were up £394

again mostly due to the cost of the bench of £460.

The Restricted Fund had a surplus of £889 (£2020) and now stands at £19,145.

Receipts at £2035 were down £1130 not having the benefit of the previous year's donation

of £1500. There were no **Payments**.

We are very grateful for the support of local people through the collection box, our fund-

raising activities and by grants and donations.
